

Cookies Policy

What are Cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on a user's computer or mobile device temporarily or permanently. Cookies are used to recognize users and track of their preferences.

First-Party Cookies: First-party cookies are created, set and accessed by the website. They are usually used to store website preferences and to maintain the browser session.

Third-Party Cookies: Third-party cookies are provided by external services/providers. They are usually used to provide targeted advertisement.

Temporary Cookies: Temporary cookies are deleted from your device when the session ends or the browser is closed.

Persistent Cookies: Persistent cookies are stored in the user's device forever or for a specific length of time. Ending the session or closing the browser does not delete persistent cookies.

What cookies do we use?

Our website uses the following third-party cookies from Google Analytics:

Cookie Name	Description
_ga	Used to distinguish users.
_gid	Used to distinguish users.
_gat	Used to throttle request rate.

How can you manage cookies?

You can manage cookies through the settings menu of your browser. For example, you may allow or block all cookies or set site-specific cookies preferences.
